

### Post Secondary Enrollment Options (PSEO)p Student Eligibility

Students attending a public or accredited nonpublic school who are in the 11th or 12th grade are eligible to participate. Also, 9th or 10th grade students who have been identified as gifted and talented are eligible to participate. Students need to consult with the counselor at their high school to determine other eligibility requirements. PSEO is only available in the academic year.

### Costs

Tuition, fees and required textbooks in most cases are free for participating students. However, students may be required to purchase additional equipment or supplies that become the property of the student. Students should discuss costs with their high school counselor. Students who withdraw/drop a course or fail a course will be responsible to their school district for the cost of the course, a \$250 fee.

### Credit

Courses are offered for college credit only. Course audit or challenge testing is not available. The local school district will determine the number of high school credits to be granted, if any, for successful completion of the course. The credit given may count toward applicable graduation requirements of the local school district; if so, the credits will be included on the student's high school transcripts.
