

APPANOOSE COUNTY YOUNG REPUBLICAN SCHOLARSHIP

A Young Republican Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating High School Senior who exemplifies academic achievement and involvement in school, community and Republican activities.

Scholarship Amount: \$500

Eligibility: **Graduating Senior...**

Attending an Appanoose County High School

-OR-

An Appanoose County resident attending High School in a neighboring county

-OR-

An Appanoose County resident that is home schooled

-AND-

Be a Registered Republican or have a Republican Party affiliation*

Must have a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative grade point average

Must enter and attend a college or university in the following Fall.

Application Process

- 1) Submit an informal letter of application providing your name, address, political affiliation, a statement as to your cumulative grade point average, and the name or names of the college or university that you will most likely attend.
- 2) Provide a list of student organizations or activities in which you have been involved throughout high school outside of classroom coursework.
- 3) Provide a list of community or church organizations in which you have been involved throughout high school.
- 4) Provide a list of involvement with the Republican Party. (Ex. Republican Central committee meetings, Appanoose County festivities, Pancake Day, Election year activities, Taste of Christmas, etc.)
- 5) Provide one letter of recommendation from an adult leader of a student, community, church, or Republican Party organization briefly describing your involvement in that organization.
- 6) A short essay (about 300 words) on the effects of politics and political organizations in everyday life, and why one should be involved in the political process.

The scholarship recipient will be reported to the high school counselor by April 15. The amount of the scholarship will be given to the recipient at a Republican activity.
