## FAQ's:

There is limited space in each program grouping. Business: 25 seats Health Sciences: 20 seats in CNA (can go up to 30 in non-CNA classes) Welding: 30 seats

The goal is to have the student register for the whole program cluster, not pick and choose in 2 or more areas.

If a student will not be 16 years old by August, it is definitely OK for them to take just the other 2 Health Sciences courses.

If a student can ONLY be at AM or PM for Business, we would consider that request. Welding likely should be in all 3 classes, unless they have already taken one that's offered.

For students going into a Career Academy or Discovery Academy after this summer that includes any of these courses: we will be looking at "alternate" courses for those students to take within their academy so it does not interfere with their overall schedule. Those courses are TBD.

This is totally free to students. They flyer says tuition, fees, books. That also includes background checks, uniforms and testing fees for CNA.
