Students satisfactorily completing all program activities based on participation and rubrics outlining activity requirements will pass the course and receive 3.0 semester credit hours of college credit.

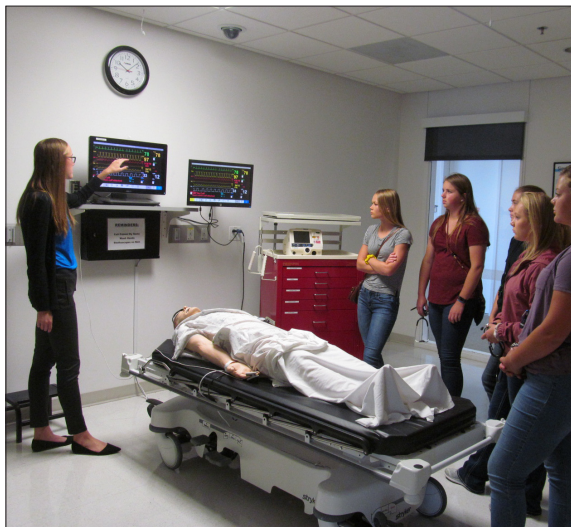
Assignments include, but are not limited to:

This program is open to high school students who will be juniors or seniors in the fall of 2019.

Participants will spend a full week (July 22-26, 2019) on the IHCC campus staying overnight in the dormitories (supervised) and then will return for classes/activities on Tuesday, July 30.

Enrollment is limited. Acceptance will be based on transcripts, student activities, volunteer work and essays concerning interest in healthcare.

The program is free to participants. Costs are paid for by the Legacy Foundation. Students successfully completing all program requirements earn three semester credit hours of college credit.

The focus of the program is to meet the following objectives:

- Recruit students with interest in science or health into health care careers
- Provide students with guidance and resources when making college plans
- Assist students in understanding and seeking financial options for college
- Promote leadership and engage students in their communities

To meet these objectives, the program will involve activities related to the following topic areas:

- Overview of different health professions
- Hands-on experiences with medical procedures and equipment
- College exploration
- Overview health care degrees
- Financial options - scholarships, grants, loans, repayment programs, etc.
- Seeking and applying for scholarships
- Guest speakers - college pathways and experiences
- Field trip(s) to area universities/medical schools (University of Iowa, Des Moines University &/or A.T. Still University)
