Dear Staff, Parents & Community Members,

On December 18, 2020, information was sent to parents, staff and community informing everyone that it was the school district's intention to return to the On-Site Learning Model (face-to-face) on Monday, January 18, 2021.

As of this coming Monday, January 18, 2021, students in grades 6-12 will move from the current Hybrid Model to On-Site learning (face to face) and students in grades PK-5 will continue with the On-Site Learning Model they have been in since the beginning of the school year.

As all of the district's students will be engaged in On-Site learning (face-to-face) on Monday, January 18, please remember if the district begins to observe increased COVID-19 absences for students and/or staff it may be necessary to consider returning to the Hybrid Model.

It is certainly our best hope that students can remain in face-to-face learning the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year and working hard at maintaining mitigation strategies will greatly improve the chances of continued face-to-face learning throughout the remainder of this school year.

As stated before, health professionals continue to urge all of us to wash our hands, wear a mask, watch your social distances and stay home when we are not feeling well. As a reminder, the mask requirements of the Centerville CSD remain in effect.
