Resolution Awarding Bid on Athletic Complex Project. Roll Call

There were three bidders on the project. FRK Architects recommends awarding the contract to the low bidder, A.T.G.-Ram Industries, LLC out of Andover, Kansas.

There were a couple of questions from the board that Rachelle Hines answered about the project. The chemical treatment for subgrade stabilization is above and beyond the base bid amount. Those dollars won't be known until the work is started and the tests are done. The storm sewer improvements costs for

bigger pipes have been included in the bid, and the bleachers are an owner item but are included in the overall project costs.

It was moved by Mike Moore and seconded by Bob Thomas to adopt the presented "Resolution Making Award of Construction Contract" as stated, accepting the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the Athletic Complex Project from A.T.G.-Ram Industries, LLC out of Andover, Kansas for the base bid amount of \$1,815,000 and a chemical treatment for subgrade stabilization amount of \$6.25 per square yard as presented. <u>Resolution Directing the Advertisement for Sale, Approving Electronic Bidding Procedures and</u> Approving Official Statement for Not to Exceed \$10,000,000 General Obligation School Bonds, Series 2021

A resolution was presented directing the advertisement for sale of not to exceed \$10,000,000 General Obligation School Bonds, Series 2021. The resolution states that bids will be received until 1:30 pm on May 10, 2021 and will be considered at a meeting to be held at 6:30 pm on May 10, 2021. The resolution also approves the electronic bidding procedure and approves the Official Statement reviewed by all board members.

Career/College Presentation

Matt Johnson and Luann Eakins gave a presentation on career and college readiness at Centerville High School. The presentation focused on four items that the state of Iowa has defined to determine if a student is college/career ready. The presentation focused on what exactly Centerville High School is doing to align with those goals.

GEAR Up Grant Presentation

Karen Swanson reported out on the GEAR Up grant (Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Programs). This grant comes around every 4-5 years and is a 7-year grant. Centerville Community Schools was one out of four new districts who have been awarded the grant for fiscal year 2022. This grant starts with a particular 6th grade class and follows them throughout their remaining school years. The dollars received are based on the enrollment of that particular class. The district is just in the beginning stages of preparation and will be meeting with grant facilitators in the coming weeks for more planning. They will report out when more information is received.

Principal Reports

All principals provided written reports to the board. Items highlighted during the meeting were: ISASP testing at various levels, gardening at Howar, process of purchasing curriculum, donation from Bridgeview Church, and reading curriculum for professional development.
