## **Student Achievement**

- We are continuing to utilize our screening data on STAR Reading and Math as well as FAST for reading to inform us of our progress. This is part of the data used to determine student interventions and enrichment that are provided during our Power Hour. We will begin using Edmentum Exact Path.
- To help struggling learners, we have students come in for extra support before or after school during our new Power UP program. Teachers and staff are available to help our students catch up and improve learning and grades.

## **Professional Development & Training**
