## **Student Achievement**

- We are pleased with our first screening! Initial FAST screening of 6<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> graders in as of 9/23/21 indicate that students have progressed toward the Fall benchmark. We are still screening students who were absent, so more information will come during October's Board Worksession.
- Fall STAR screening will be administered through October 8<sup>th</sup> to monitor growth and progress in reading and math.

Using the data from FAST, STAR, attendance/grades, and teacher feedback will help us determine how to power up our students with interventions and enrichment.

## **Professional Development & Programs**

- Several of our HMS Building Leadership Team members are part of a Standards-Based Grading pilot
  to begin implementing standards-based grading practices at the middle school. Kudo's to Jolonda
  Mihalovich, Shawna Jacobsen, and Krishna Carlyle for being part of this team! This will be a
  multiyear journey of improvement which fits with our building and district plans for improvement.
- In partnership with our Centerville Police Department, we will be conducting ALICE Training during our October 11<sup>th</sup> PD day with our entire staff. With new staff and a few years since we were able to review our active shooter/intruder drills, it is important to train and refresh ourselves on protocols.
