ISASP Student Honor Code

This document outlines expectations for student behavior, at Howar Middle School, during and after ISASP (formerly known as the Iowa Assessments) testing. Prohibited behaviors include, but are not limited to:

- a. Using personal electronics to capture test items or responses.
- b. Providing assistance to or accepting assistance from other students, which includes copying answers, using prearranged signals to provide answers, sharing used scratch paper, etc.
- c. Discussing test items or responses with students who have not yet tested.
- d. Sharing test tickets, or retaining tickets or scratch paper after testing.

Any direct violations will be reported to the Iowa Department of Education. Please remind your students of the importance of ISASP testing and following the Student Honor Code.

As a reminder, cell phones, smart watches and other similar devices are prohibited in the testing classroom.
