Dear Parents/Guardians:

This year the Centerville Schools will be registering students online from Wednesday, July 20th to Sunday, July 31st. All student registrations will be done online this year.

Centerville Schools will use Enrollment Express for our E-Registration process. Parents and Guardians will have the opportunity to change demographic information online using your Parent PowerSchool log-in or, if you are a new user, by creating an account. If you are a new user you will need to call your student's school to create an account. Only **one** parent/guardian will be able to register a student. After the student's registration process is complete both parents or guardians will be able to create an access account.

If you do not have access to a computer, tablet, or smartphone, you may contact your student's school to schedule a time to register at the building. By completing this information online, it provides our staff with accurate information to better protect your student. This year you will be able to use the PowerSchool Mobile App to register your student/students.
