Approval of Lease Agreement with Indian Hills

It was moved by Derek Carter and seconded by Bob Thomas to approve the lease agreement with Indian Hills Community College for their use of space at the High School as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

New Business

<u>Resolution Formally Approving and Adopting the Plans, Specifications, Form of Contract and Estimated</u> <u>Total Cost of the Centerville High School Addition Project</u>

Kevin Wiskus discussed that the bids came in higher than previous projections. The district is working with the architect to look at value-engineering items as well as other funding sources to cover the shortfall. Options at this point are to: approve the plans and continue with value-engineering discussions to reduce costs, re-bid the project at a later date, or table the action.

Matt Gillaspie with Piper Sandler was present virtually. He asked to present before the board made their decision. It was moved by Bob Thomas and seconded by Kris Shondel to table the action until later in the meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Matt Gillapsie went over the information related specifically to the Sales Tax Revenue bond bids received earlier in the afternoon. He also shared a board packet with financial information with all of the known funding sources for the High School Addition Project as well as other possible funding sources to cover the costs of the shortfall. He presented projections with the use of cash as well as another Sales Tax Revenue Bond issuance and explained that the board could proceed given the current assumptions. Attention to cash balances, current budgets, and future Voted PPEL would be needed.

The District is still interested in conversations about value-engineering and will continue discussions with the architect as well as at the board level.

After Matt Gillaspie's presentation and after action on other items, it was moved by Mike Moore and seconded by Bob Thomas to adopt the "Resolution Formally Approving and Adopting the Plans, Specifications, Form of Contract and Estimated Total Cost of the Centerville High School Addition Project" as stated after meeting all public hearing requirements.
